Blossomberg Cemetery Lots

The old sections of Blossomberg Cemetery total four acres. In the new addition we have almost seven acres. We will have plenty of lots available so there is no need to worry that you will not be able to obtain one. The lots are limited to residents or property owners of the Town of Gibraltar. However, if you have

an immediate family relative that is buried there, you will be allowed to purchase lots.

One small, separate strip of the new addition to Blossomberg Cemetery is divided into lots that will be sold over the next few months. The remainder of the first acre to be developed will be leveled, top soil added; then seeded.

Once the lots are marked by a surveyor we will begin to sell those lots. We are sending letters to all persons on the Blossomberg Cemetery waiting list as lots become available. All persons on the waiting list for lots at Blossomberg Cemetery will be accommodated.
